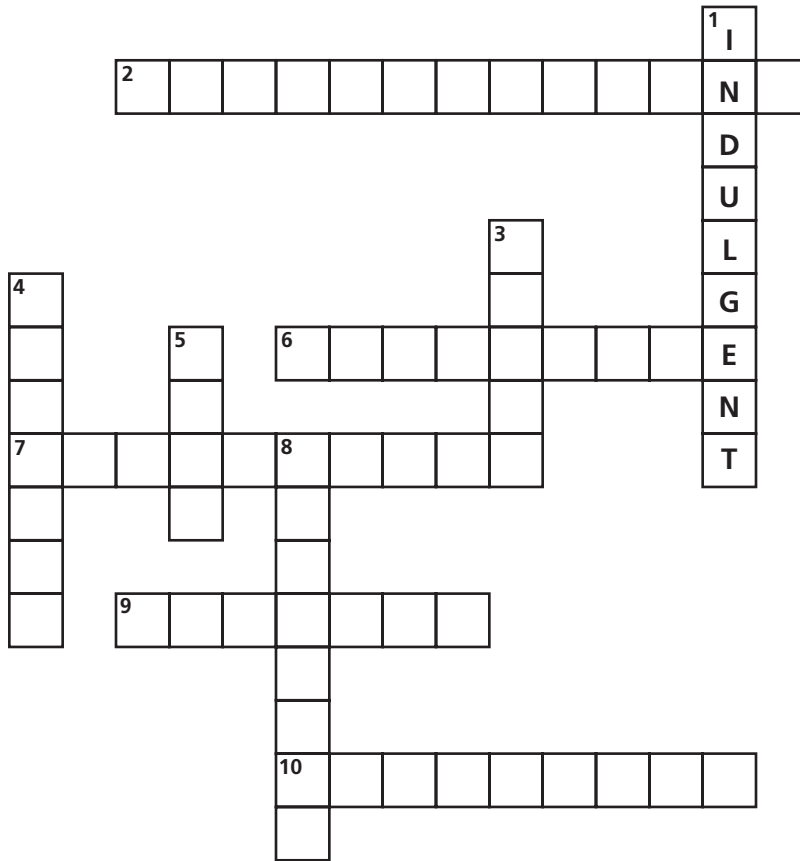


Crossword Puzzle
