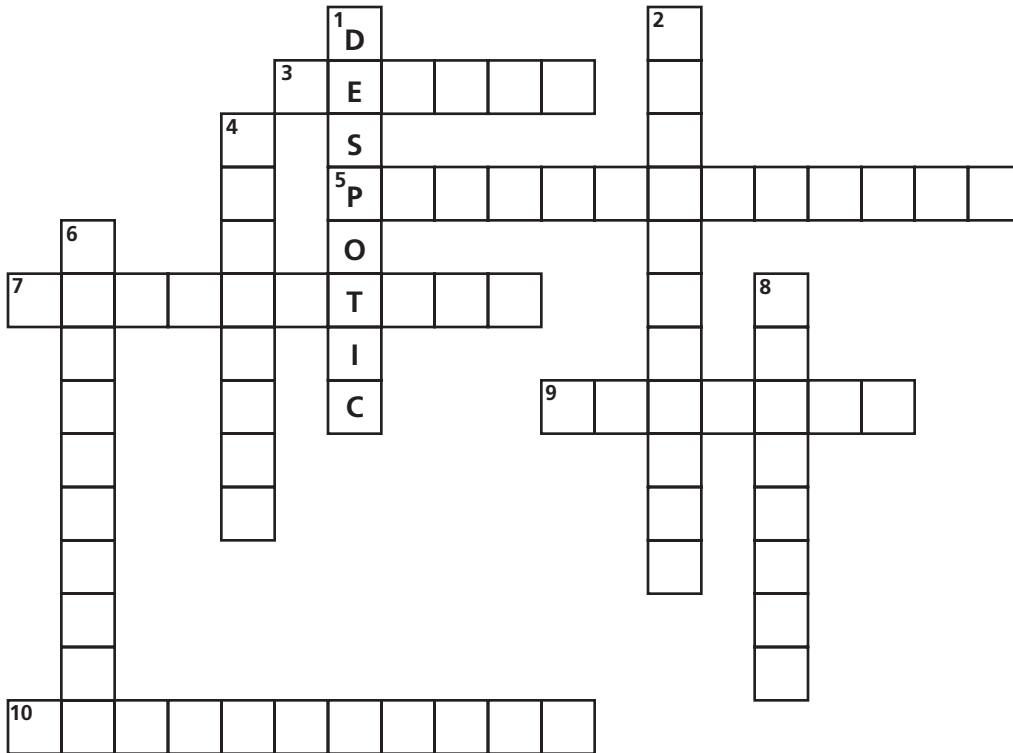


# Crossword Puzzle
