accommodate (uh KOM uh dayt) If you accommodate others, you give them what they need or want.

annex (AN ehks) When a place has been annexed, it has been taken over.

authoritative (uh THAWR uh TAY tihv) An authoritative person is powerful and knowledgeable.

conclusive (kuhn KLOO sihv) If something is conclusive, it is final or certain.

confine (kuhn FYN) A person who is confined to a place is kept from leaving it.

disgruntled (dihs GRUHN tuhld) If you are disgruntled, you are angry and dissatisfied. **embroil** (ehm BROYL) If you are embroiled in something, you are mixed up in something bad, such as a fight.

impartiality (IHM pahr shee AL uh tee) Someone who acts with impartiality acts fairly and does not favor one side over another.

relevant (REHL uh vuhnt) If something is relevant, it is connected to what is being talked about at the time.

turmoil (TUR moyl) Things are in turmoil when they are confused and out of order.
