

## Words and Explanations

**accommodate** (uh KOM uh dayt) If you accommodate others, you give them what they need or want.

**annex** (AN ehks) When a place has been annexed, it has been taken over.

**authoritative** (uh THAWR uh TAY tihv) An authoritative person is powerful and knowledgeable.

**conclusive** (kuhn KLOO sihv) If something is conclusive, it is final or certain.

**confine** (kuhn FYN) A person who is confined to a place is kept from leaving it.

**disgruntled** (dihs GRUHN tuhld) If you are disgruntled, you are angry and dissatisfied.

**embroil** (ehm BROYL) If you are embroiled in something, you are mixed up in something bad, such as a fight.

**impartiality** (IHM pahr shee AL uh tee) Someone who acts with impartiality acts fairly and does not favor one side over another.

**relevant** (REHL uh vuhnt) If something is relevant, it is connected to what is being talked about at the time.

**turmoil** (TUR moyl) Things are in turmoil when they are confused and out of order.
